2017 FALL SCHEDULE

The 2017 fall semester will begin on August 14 and end on December 11. There will be NO lessons on Labor Day (Sept. 4) or the week of Thanksgiving (Nov. 20-24). Our Christmas Music Showcase will take place on December 16 at the Epicenter.

TUITION RATES/DETAILS

30min lesson: \$30

45min lesson: \$45

60min lesson: \$60

Tuition is prepaid each month. Tuition is due on the first day of the month and is based on the actual lessons that will take place in that month. Each month may be different. If a debit/credit card is on file and authorized, the office will manually draft music accounts on the 1st of each month. Check and cash payments can be made at the front desk prior to the first lesson of each month. Lessons will not be given if tuition is not paid. Late tuition will incur a \$15 fee on the 5th day of the month.

Teachers keep a lesson completion sheet for the semester. The student/parent will sign this sheet at the end of each lesson. On the last lesson of the semester, the completion sheet will be sent home with the student, confirming all lessons were completed.

MUSIC SHOWCASES

Live performances are crucial to what we do at the Epicenter! We will end the semester with our Christmas Music Showcase on December 16 from 3-5p at the Epicenter. There will be a \$10 showcase fee due with normal tuition on Dec. 1. The showcase fee will include 4 tickets and a program. Participation in the showcase is not mandatory, but highly encouraged!

TRIAL LESSONS

A 30 minute trial music lesson may be scheduled prior to registration. Trial lessons are a one-time charge of \$30 (the cost of one regular 30 minute lesson) and are set up through the Epicenter office.

MISSED LESSONS AND MAKE-UP LESSONS

Each student will be allowed 2 make-up lessons per semester. 24 hour notice is required in order to receive a make-up lesson (illness or family emergencies being the exception). The music teacher MUST be given notice prior to the lesson start time. Each music teacher will be available on two designated make-up days per semester. Make-ups cannot carry over to the following semester. If a teacher misses a lesson without notification, the makeup lesson will be free. Reschedules initiated by the teacher will not count towards the student's 2 makeup lessons for the semester.

PUNCTUALITY

Please remember that each student has reserved his/her specific lesson time within the teacher's schedule. The teacher cannot allow a lesson to extend into the next student's lesson time. If the student is late, the lesson will end at the designated time.

WITHDRAWAL FROM LESSONS

If withdrawal from music lessons is necessary, you must do so by the 20th of the month or you will be charged for the following month. This must be done in writing and signed off by the front desk; teachers are not allowed to withdraw students. By enrolling in a private lesson, you have reserved a spot that could be released for someone else. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding of this policy.
