



Tuition 2018-19

Dance, Acting and Art Classes

A non-refundable annual registration fee is due per participant in order to secure each participant's position in our program. Registration Fee is \$45 for the first student, \$30 for the second student, \$75 is the Family Cap.

Tuition is due the first of each month beginning August 1st – May 1st. With the exception of August, which will be pro-rated, your monthly tuition will be the same regardless of holidays or the number of weeks in a given month. Tuition fees are to be paid monthly unless previously arranged with Epicenter for the Arts. A \$15 late fee will be added after the 5th day of the month.

Individual Cap Rate - \$300/month (Does not apply to company rates)

Class Pass and Drop-In rate is \$20 for 1 class or \$90 for 5 classes. Class passes are non-refundable and non-transferable and offered for any classes on our regular monthly schedule. Sorry, this is not available for Master classes, workshops, or any Epi Company classes.

Placements are \$10 for one class, \$15 for 2 class placements, and \$20 for 3 class placements.

All music lessons are considered private. Please call for more information.

Costume and Showcase Fees

Costumes

Costume(s) are required for your dancer to participate in our June Showcase. Costumes are made to order and take 8-12 weeks to produce. Costume orders must be placed during Christmas break, therefore, your **NON REFUNDABLE** costume deposit must be collected on or before November 1st. If for some reason the participant is not planning to complete the year, you must notify us in writing prior to November 1st and you will not be charged a costume fee.

Epicenter for the Arts will assume that each registered student will be performing in the June Showcase. The following costume fee per class will be due November 1st.

- \$65 (for Ages 3-6) per class, includes Tiny Combo, Epi Combo, Acro Jazz, and Pre Hop
- \$75 per class (See below for Ballet Costume fees)

Ballet Costumes

Ballet Level 1 and up has a \$120 costume fee.

For your convenience, the Ballet costume fee will be divided into two payments:

- \$75 Non-refundable Costume Deposit , due by November 1st:
- \$45 Ballet Costume Balance due by March 1.
If the remaining balance of a ballet costume is not paid by March 31, the student may not receive a costume, and the deposit will not be refunded.

If a ballet student **withdraws** from ballet class before the \$45 balance has been paid, they must pay the deposit when they withdraw in order to receive the ballet costume. Otherwise they will forego the \$75 deposit for the ballet costume and will not receive a ballet costume.

Showcase Fee

A \$35 Showcase Fee will be applied for **each student** and will be posted to your account and is due by February 1st, \$105 family maximum. If for some reason the dancer is not planning to participate in the June Showcase, you must notify us in writing prior to November 1st.

Private Dance Lesson Fees

Private Lessons are scheduled by Epicenter for the Arts staff, please call 817-778-8828 to schedule private lessons.

- Payment for the lesson is due 24 hours prior to the time the private lesson is scheduled and it is non-refundable.
- If the student needs to cancel, the office must be given a 24 hour notice.
If the student cancels within 24 hours, no refund or credit will be given.
- If the teacher cancels within 24 hours, a credit will be given to the families account and will also be given one free private lesson (of equal value).
